Professional background

Dr Tanveer Ahmed is the Medical Superintendent at Kellyville Private Hospital.

He is a general adult psychiatrist with over twenty years of experience. He sees patients aged between 16 and 70 across the spectrum of mental health diagnoses. He trained across New South Wales after gaining his medical degree from the University of Sydney.
